

## Author to reveal book adventures

MARTIN Kari will bring to the local area his experience of writing 12 books in English and 12 in German as well as his recent trip to a renowned book fair.

At a Meet the Author event the author of books including *Australia: A Migrant Experience*, and *Journey of a Lifetime* will talk about his experience of

representing Australia at the Frankfurt International Book Fair.

"I will bring 180 pictures so people can also visually experience what I'm talking about," Mr Kari said.

He will also discuss his experience in Australia.

"I have brought out in the last books, an aspect of Aboriginal culture which is very important overseas because many people don't know about the history of Australia," he said.

"The real Australia is outside the cities and I want to make people aware that we have something still unique that we can be proud

of."

Mr Kari is not writing after nine years of almost constant writing.

"At the moment I have given a bit of time to myself because I was writing between 10 and 12 hours daily and I've decided to give myself a little break because there are other things to do," he said.

He wants to spend some of this time giving talks and meeting the community.

"A talk like this can be very helpful for an author because you can hear outside your own ideas," he said.

"I want to bring the whole community with me so they know what is happening."
